The purpose of this Public Notice is to inform the general public that the Huntington District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Huntington District) has decided to accept and expend funds contributed by the West Virginia Department of Transportation (WVDOT). The State and/or Federal funds contributed by the WVDOT in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will be used to expedite permit application evaluation. Huntington District will be evaluating all WVDOT highway projects within the entire State of West Virginia.

On February 1, 2006, the two Corps Districts in West Virginia published a Public Notice announcing our proposal to accept and expend such funds. The notice also discussed the kind of activities for which funds would be expended and the safeguarding procedures which would be used to ensure that the funds will not impact impartial decision making.
