## CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING

### HUNTINGTON DISTRICT


### OHIO AND KANAWHA RIVERS

Notice is given that on or about 13 June 2013, Amherst Madison will commence clamshell dredging in the lower approach of Winfield Locks, Kanawha River, mile 31.1. Then, on or about 20 June, the contractor will move to Robert C. Byrd Locks, Ohio River, mile 279.6. Disposal operations will take place at an approved site located near the dams.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V EARL FRANKLIN, two barge mounted cranes and three material barges. The M/V EARL FRANKLIN will be in the vicinity of the dredge sites and should be contacted for passing arrangements on marine channel 13 or 72. Dredging will be performed from 6:00 am to midnight, 7 days per week. A government dredge inspector will be in attendance at each site.

Navigators are requested to be alert to the location of the dredge and its disposal operations. The dredge and attendant plant will be marked and lighted according to regulations. It is essential that navigators await the passing signal from the dredge prior to proceeding with caution.
