CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING

HUNTINGTON DISTRICT


OHIO AND KANAWHA RIVERS

Notice is given that on or about 26 April 2014, Amherst Madison will commence clamshell dredging in the lower approach of Robert C. Byrd Locks, Ohio River, mile 279.6. Then, on or about 2 May 2014, the contractor begin performance of the same at Winfield Locks, Kanawha River, mile 31.1. Disposal operations will take place at the permitted sites located below each dam.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V BUS BROWN, the M/V MILTON, two barge mounted cranes, and three material barges. The M/V BUS BROWN will be in the vicinity of the dredge sites and should be contacted for passing arrangements on marine channel 13. Dredging will be performed from 6:00 AM through midnight, 7 days per week. A government dredge inspector will be in attendance at each site.

Navigators are requested to be alert to the location of the dredge and its disposal operations. It is essential that navigators await the passing signal from the dredge prior to proceeding with caution. During non-working hours, all equipment will be moored outside the navigation channel, marked and lighted according to regulations.
