CORE BORING


OHIO RIVER, MILE 315.0

Notice is given that on or about 10 October 2014, Amherst Madison Inc. will commence core drilling operations on the Ohio River, mile 315.0, along the left descending edge of the navigation channel.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of M/V LADY LOIS and one barge mounted crane. The M/V LADY LOIS will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and is expected to be completed on or about 17 October 2014.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the Merdie Boggs facility along the left descending bank on the Ohio River, mile 317.8, and will be lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake, and proceed with caution.
