



Call for Abstracts

ORBCRE Symposium 2017 Co-Sponsored by ORBA Marshall University, 27 – 29 September 2017

The 33rd annual Scientific Symposium of the Ohio River Basin Consortium for Research & Education (ORBCRE) will be hosted by Marshall University in Huntington, WV, and is being co-sponsored by the Ohio River Basin Alliance (ORBA). The theme for the symposium is *“Partnerships Across the Ohio River Basin”*. Panel discussions are scheduled for Education & Outreach, Inland Navigation, Citizen Science, Flood Control & Risk Reduction, Drone-Based Assessment, Harmful Algal Blooms, Water Quality Monitoring, Citizen Engagement, Recreation & Tourism, and Environmental Restoration. Abstracts on those subjects or other topics of interest to Ohio River Basin stakeholders are being accepted for review. Selected submissions will be assigned to a panel session, platform presentation, or poster presentation.

Abstracts, limited to one page (one-inch margins, 11-point font or larger), should be submitted as an email attachment in MSWord. All submissions should include a descriptive title and email, postal address, and institutional affiliations for all authors. The corresponding author must be identified. **The deadline for submitting abstracts is 1 August 2017.** Notification of the disposition of abstracts will be sent by email on or before 15 August.
