

DEWEY LAKE TO BEGIN ANNUAL POOL DRAWDOWN

PRESTONSBURG, KY - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Dewey Lake will begin drawing the lake down to winter pool elevation of 645 feet (msl) on November 01, 2013. Dewey Lake is currently at summer or conservation pool at an elevation of 650 feet (msl). The 30 day drawdown period is normally completed by 1 December. Boaters are reminded that the Goble Branch boat launch ramp is the only boat launching facility that will be in service and accessible at winter pool.
