The Corps master plan for Dewey Lake is being updated. The new master plan will become the strategic land use management document that guides the comprehensive management, development and use of recreational facilities, natural resources, and cultural resources. It is a vital tool for responsible stewardship and sustainability of land and water resources for the benefit of present and future generations. The master plan guides Corps responsibilities pursuant to federal laws to preserve, conserve, restore, maintain, manage, and develop the land, water, and associated resources.

The master plan will establish a new set of resource use objectives that will serve as the guide for future management and development of the lake. The master planning effort will involve the analysis of past, present, and future environmental recreational, and socioeconomic conditions and trends. The master planning process focuses on four primary components, 1) regional and ecosystem needs, 2) project resource capabilities and suitability, 3) expressed public interests that are compatible with Dewey Lake's authorized purposes, and 4) environmental sustainability elements.

The public meeting on April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 will provide the public with the opportunity to learn more about the Corps master plan process and provide input as to the future management and development of the lakes recreational facilities and natural resources.
