MAINTENANCE DREDGING

RACINE LOCKS AND DAM OHIO RIVER, MILE 237.5

GREENUP LOCKS AND DAM OHIO RIVER, MILE 341.0

Notice is given that on or about 20 August 2008, Madison Coal and Supply, contractor for US Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District, will commence maintenance dredging behind the upper guide walls of the Racine Locks and Dam, Ohio River mile 237.5 (20 August through 28 August 2008) and Greenup Locks and Dam Ohio River mile 341.0 (29 August through 8 September 2008).

The floating plant will consist of the M/V LADY LOIS one crane barge and two material barges. The M/V LADY LOIS will be monitoring marine channel 13. The work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. It is anticipated this work will be completed on or about 8 September 2008. The dredged material will be disposed in the approved upstream disposal area (above the dam), outside of the lock approach.

The floating plant will be moored at the site during non-working hours and will be lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
