I refer to Public Notice No. 2003-00238-KAN regarding a proposal by Alex Energy to dispose of fill material into waters of the United States in conjunction with surface mining activities at the proposed Republic No. 1 Mine near Carbon, Kanawha County, West Virginia. Due to an administrative error, the original public notice indicated a closing date for submittal of comments of March 9, 2009. Corps regulations require a 30-day comment period.
