REGULATORY GUIDANCE ON SURFACE COAL MINING ACTIVITIES

The purpose of this notice is to advise and clarify a determination of acceptable information for evaluating impacts to jurisdictional waters of the U. S., resulting from surface coal mining activities. The submittal of a Preconstruction Notification (PCN), as required under Nationwide Permit (NWP) 21, as well as, individual permit applications must include acceptable functional assessment methodologies consistent with the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency's Rapid Bioassessment Method. One acceptable method is the Eastern Kentucky Stream Assessment Protocol (EKSAP), which is a scientifically-based assessment method used to assess a stream's (or a particular segment of stream) ecological integrity or functional aquatic value. The EKSAP can be used to correlate a monetary figure from a stream's ecological integrity. This office will evaluate acceptable functional assessment data along with any proposed mitigation to determine if a project will result in more than minimal impacts to jurisdictional waters.
