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## BRIDGE DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION

### COAL RIVER, MILE 0.2

Notice is given that on or about March 10, 2004, National Engineering and Contracting Company, St. Albans, West Virginia, contractor for West Virginia Department of Highways, Charleston, West Virginia, will commence dismantling the existing U. S. Route 60 Bridge over the Coal River, mile 0.2.

The contractor's fleet will consist of the M/V TUBBY TOOTER, one barge mounted crane and four material barges. The M/V TUBBY TOOTER will be monitoring marine channel 13. Work will be performed seven days per week from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and construction is anticipated to be completed on or about November 5, 2005.

All floating plants will be moored at the work site during non-working hours and will be lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
