DAMAGED WATER INTAKE

KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 81.1

Notice is given that during the recent high water periods, the Pratt, West Virginia municipal water intake located along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 81.1 has suffered damage and should be avoided by mariners transiting the area.

In the interest of navigation safety on the waterways, users are reminded that when the river level is above the ordinary high water elevation, all vessels should be operating near the sailing line to prevent damage to river banks and structures situated thereon or adjacent thereto. (See 33 CFR 207.300 (U)).
