EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT

OHIO RIVER, MILE 403.0

Notice is given that on or about 10 June 2004, Madison Coal and Supply Company, contractor for the Road Fork Development, a subsidiary of Massey Energy, will begin the replacement of the unloading crane at Carmeuse Lime facility along the left descending bank on the Ohio River, mile 403.0.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V FLORENCE T, one barge mounted crane, and one deck barge. The M/V FLORENCE T will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. Work will be performed between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. seven days per week, and it is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 7 July 2004. During non-working hours the contractor's floating plant will be moored at the worksite.

Mariners are urged to use extreme caution in the area.
