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## MITIGATION STRUCTURES

### KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 77.5 to MILE 78.7

Notice is given that on or about 01 June 2004, Madison Coal and Supply Company, contractor for the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District, will begin the placement of concrete rubble from the Marmet Locks project along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 77.5 to mile 78.7.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V LADY LOIS, one barge mounted crane, and one material barge. The M/V LADY LOIS will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. Work will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Saturday, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on or about 30 July 2004.

During non-working hours the contractor's floating plant will be moored along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 78.0, adjacent to the project and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to use extreme caution in the area.
