REVISION TO MITIGATION STRUCTURES

KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 73.8 to MILE 74.5

Reference Notice to Navigation Interests No. 04-17, dated 16 April 2004.

The location of the activities has moved across the river to the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 73.8 to 74.5. The M/V LADY LOIS has been replaced by the M/V MAJOR. The M/V MAJOR will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The anticipated end date has been extended to 31 July 2004. All other information remains the same.

For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 04-24:

Notice is given that on or about 30 April 2004, Madison Coal and Supply Company, contractor for the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District, will begin placing mitigation structures consisting of timbers and root wads along the right descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 73.8 to mile 74.5.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V LADY LOIS, one barge mounted crane, and one material barge. The M/V LADY LOIS will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. Work will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on or about 30 June 2004.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the work site and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to use extreme caution in the area.
