
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: The following application has been submitted for a Department of the Army Permit under the provisions of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

CORRECTION: Public Notice Number 200400796 issued on June 27, 2004 for the applicant's proposed project erroneously states on page 4 "The primary reason for the selection of the Rich Creek site as an appropriate mitigation area was the solicitation by the West Virginia Chapter of Trout Unlimited (WVTU) for support in restoring and or enhancing certain impaired stream segments of Rich Creek. Much of the impairment can be attributed to the streambank structure and stability and the lack of an adequate riparian zone. WVTU has offered its assistance in implementing the project and they have provided the applicant with stream improvement measures that they believe will promote stream stability and enhancement of fisheries."

Public Notice Number 200400796 issued on June 27, 2004 is hereby revised as follows: "The primary reason for the selection of the Rich Creek site as an appropriate mitigation area was the solicitation by the Kanawha Valley Chapter of Trout Unlimited (KVCTU) for support in restoring and or enhancing certain impaired stream segments of Rich Creek. Much of the impairment can be attributed to the streambank structure and stability and the lack of an adequate riparian zone. KVCTU has offered its assistance in implementing the project and they have provided the applicant with stream improvement measures that they believe will promote stream stability and enhancement of fisheries."
