SUBMERGED OUTFALL INSTALLATION

OHIO RIVER, MILE 273.0

Notice is given that on or about 09 August 2004, Madison Coal and Supply Company will begin the installation of a submerged outfall along the left descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 273.0 for Akzo Noble Functional Chemical, LLC. The diffuser will extend approximately 112 feet into the river from the normal pool shoreline.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V MAJOR, one material barge, and one floating crane. The M/V MAJOR will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and it is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 15 September 2004. During non working hours, the contractor's floating plant will be moored at the work site, and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
