RIVER CROSSING PIPELINE INSPECTION

BIG SANDY RIVER, MILE 3.2

Notice is given that on or about 10 August 2004, Underwater Services, Ltd. will begin inspecting a pipeline river crossing for Markwest Hydrocarbon Co. along the right descending bank of the Big Sandy River, mile 3.2. The work area will be marked and not exceed 200 feet from the normal pool shoreline. International alpha code and recreational dive flags will be displayed.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of a twenty-five foot Pontoon boat used as a diving platform. This vessel will be monitoring marine channel 13. The work will be performed between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., and it is anticipated that this work will be completed in one day.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
