MAINTENANCE DREDGING

OHIO RIVER, MILE 345.0

Notice is given that on or about 07 September 2004, Madison Coal and Supply Co. will begin dredging along the right descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 345.0, at the Norfolk Southern Corporation facility.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V MILTON, the M/V LUCEDALE, one barge mounted crane, and eight material barges. The M/V MILTON will be transporting to and from the disposal site, and the M/V LUCEDALE will remain at the dredge site. Both vessels will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. Work will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. It is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 30 October 2004. The disposal area will be in an approved upland area located at the O-KAN Harbor on the right descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 266.4

During non-working hours, the contractor's floating plant will be moored at the work site and lighted according to regulation.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and to proceed with caution.
