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## MAINTENANCE DREDGING

### OHIO RIVER, MILE 250.2

Notice is given that on or about 14 September 2004, O-KAN Marine Company will begin dredging along the right descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 250.2, at the Pomeroy, Ohio municipal boat dock.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V ANDREW J, one barge mounted crane, and one material barge. The M/V ANDREW J will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 8. Work will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. It is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 21 September 2004. The disposal area will be in an approved upland area located at the O-KAN Harbor on the right descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 266.4

During non-working hours, the contractor's floating plant will be moored at the work site and lighted according to regulation.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and to proceed with caution.
