REVISION TO NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS 04-57

INSTALLATION OF PIPELINE CROSSING

KANAWHA RIVER MILE 88.9

Reference Notice to Navigation Interests 04-57 dated 20 August 2004. Due to environmental circumstances, the start date has been delayed. Until 18 October 2004, and the anticipated completion date is on or about 26 November 2004. All other pertinent information remains the same.

For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 04-57:

Notice is given that on or about 02 September 2004, Madison Coal and Supply will begin the installation of a submarine pipeline crossing for Kanawha Falls Public Service District on the Kanawha River, mile 88.9.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V MAJOR, two barge mounted cranes, and two material barges. The M/V MAJOR will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. Work will be performed 7 days per week, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. It is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 02 October 2004.

During non-working hours, the contractor's floating plant will be moored at the work site along the right descending bank.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and to proceed with caution.
