REVISION TO NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS 04-79

FACILITY MAINTENANCE DREDGING

KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 60.9

Reference Notice to Navigation Interests 04-79 dated 7 December 2004. Due to unanticipated high water, the start and completion dates have been changed, the start date is now 7 February 2005 and the anticipated completion date is 5 March 2005. All other pertinent information remains the same.

For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 04-79:

Notice is given that on or about 3 January 2005, The Charleston Boat Club will commence dredging at their facility, along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 60.9.

The floating plant will consist of one unnamed dredging vessel and one material barge. The dredging vessel will be monitoring marine channel 16 at the worksite. Work will be performed Monday thru Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. It is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 3 February 2005. The material will be placed upland along the right descending bank of the Ohio River, mile 265.0, on O-Kan Harbor property.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the work site and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and to proceed with caution.
