## DIVING OPERATIONS

### KANAWHA RIVER, MILES 80.5 to 82.8

Notice is given that on or about 26 June 2006, the West Virginia Department of Natural Resources in conjunction with the US Fish and Wildlife Service will conduct diving operations across the channel of the Kanawha River, miles 80.5 to 82.8. International alpha code and recreational dive flags will be displayed.

The floating plant will consist of one 24' dive boat and one 18' support boat equipped with marine radios monitoring channel 13. Diving will be performed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and it is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 30 June 2006.

As this work requires divers to work across the navigation channel, mariners are urged to contact the dive boat prior to passing to acquire the location of the divers. If the divers are within the navigation channel, they will recover and exit the navigation channel prior to vessels passing. If the divers are out of the navigation channel, mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
