FACILITY MAINTENANCE DREDGING

OHIO RIVER, MILE 258.0

Notice is given that on or about 3 August 2006, Madison Coal and Supply will commence maintenance dredging at the Kyger Creek Plant, on the Ohio River, mile 258.0, along the right descending bank.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V FRED SHED, one barge mounted crane, and three material barges. The M/V FRED SHED will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The dredged material will be disposed in an approved upland disposal area at the Kyger Creek Plant. The work will be performed Monday through Friday 07:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and it is anticipated that the work will be completed on or about 1 September 2006.

During non-working hours the contractor's floating plant will be moored at the work site, and lighted according to regulation.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and to proceed with caution.
