



# Huntington District Regulatory & Surrounding Districts





**Section 404 of the Clean Water Act**

Includes smaller streams (with a defined bed and bank) and wetlands

**Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899**

Water bodies are considered navigable if they meet any of 4 criteria

- Presently used for transportation of commerce
- Used in the past for transportation of commerce
- Not presently used, nor used in the past for transportation of commerce, but could be made so with "reasonable improvements"
- Subject to the ebb and flow of the tide

**Differences in Scope of Section 10 and Section 404 Regulatory Authorities**

<u>Authority</u>	<u>Regulated Activity</u>	<u>Water Subject to Jurisdiction</u>
Section 10	[structures or work in, on, over, under]	[navigable waters]
Section 404	[discharge of dredged or fill material into]	[waters of U.S., including wetlands]

*\*Some projects require authorizations under both Section 10 and Section 404 authorities, although such projects receive a single authorization.*

- Tug Fork (TUG)** - mouth to mile 58.0 (Louisa, KY to Williamson, WV)

**West Virginia Section 10 Streams**

- Big Coal River (BCR)** - mouth to mile 57.9 (St. Albans, WV to Jarrolds Valley, WV)
- Elk River (ELK)** - mouth to mile 139.0 (Charleston, WV to Webster Springs, WV)
- Gauley River (GAU)** - mouth to mile 75.0 (Gauley Bridge, WV to mouth of Williams River at Camden in Gauley, WV)
- Greenbrier River (GBR)** - mouth to mile 150.5 (Hinton, WV to Durbin, WV)
- Guyandotte River (GUY)** - mouth to mile 122.0 (Huntington, WV to Clear Fork, WV)
- Kanawha River (KAN)** - mouth to mile 97.0 (Glen Ferris, WV to Point Pleasant, WV)
- Little Kanawha River (LKR)** - mouth to mile 130.75 (Parkersburg, WV to Bulltown, WV)
- New River (NEW)** - mouth to mile 87.5 (Gauley Bridge, WV to the Virginia state line near Roundbottom Creek, WV)

**Ohio Section 10 Streams**

- Hocking River (HOC)** - mouth to mile 79.0 (Hockingport, OH to Rush Creek, OH)
- Muskingum River (MUS)** - mouth to mile 112.5 (Marietta, OH to Coshocton, OH)
- Olentangy River (OLR)** - mouth to mile 74.3 (Columbus, OH to Seccaium Park, OH)
- Scioto River (SCR)** - mouth to mile 175.0 (Portsmouth, OH to Greencamp, OH)
- Tuscarawas River (TUS)** - mouth to mile 113.3 (Coshocton, OH to Akron, OH)
- Walhonding River (WAL)** - mouth to mile 8.8 (Coshocton, OH to Six Mile Dam, OH)
- Great Miami River (GMR)** - mouth to mile 117.0
- Little Miami River (LMR)** - mouth to mile 90.7
- East Fk. Little Miami River (ELM)** - mouth to mile 6.4
- Wabash River (WAB)** - mouth to Wells/Adams County lines in Indiana (Section 10 drainage in Ohio)

*\*Note: Authorities under Section 10 Navigable Waters does include certain "slack water" extents.*
