Regional Review Plan Consistency Certification

1. Provide a Brief Description of Study or Project, Geographic Location, Project Sponsor and Proposed National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Compliance Activities:

The City of Marietta is proposing to design and construct a sanitary sewer system extension for the area near Commerce Drive in Reno, Ohio along Route 7 to the area near the Polar Service Center, including a tie-in to Mondo Polymer Technologies. The sewer system extension will serve approximately 55 new customers. The need for improvements in the proposed area is to reduce safety concerns and risk to the public health.

The preferred alternative would be to design and construct a new sewer service. Phase 1 will consist of installing a sewer mainline from the Commerce Drive tie-in to Mondo Polymers, including force main and gravity sewer of approximately 1.6 miles. Phase 2 will consist of laterals and spurs associated with the Phase 1 mainline. Phase 3 will consist of sewer mainline, laterals, and spurs from Mondo Polymers to the Polar Service Center, including force main and gravity sewer of approximately 0.4 miles in Reno and the surrounding area.

The proposed project is a partnership agreement between the City of Marietta and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers established under the authority of Section 594 of the Water Resources and Development Act (WRDA) of 1999 (Public Law 106-53) and WRDA of 2007, Section 5155, as amended.

The Huntington District's Engineering Staff, an active part of the Project Delivery Team, reviews all plans and specs to ensure appropriate design and location, working closely with the Non-Federal Sponsor. An Environmental Assessment will be prepared for this project.


