Contracts We Use

(Types of Contracts typically utilized by OR-TM)

Fabrication Contracts

(Lock and Dam gate components, culvert valve components, bulkheads, bridges, stairwells, handrails)

Equipment Contracts

(Rentals and purchasing of cranes and material handlers such as forklifts and telehandlers)

Supply Contracts

(steel, alloys, electrical supplies, bolts and fasteners, gate seal material, hydraulic supplies, tools, gearboxes, chemicals, rigging, PPE, dive equipment, LHE equipment)

Sandblasting and Painting Contracts

(On and Off Site – Machinery, bulkheads, gates and components)



PRESSURE VESSEL INSPECTION



- Approximately 165 pressure vessels in need of periodic inspection.
- Water and air pressure tanks.
- Varies from horizontal/vertical or portable/stationary.
- PSI ranging from 35-200.
- Volumes ranging from 1-3000 gal.
- Multiple areas in need of service.

Inspections and tests will be performed by personnel qualified in accordance with the ASME Code and the NBBI Code.

- Tests for temporary or portable systems and equipment required every 6 months.
- Tests for permanent systems and equipment required every 1 year.
- Various circumstances may result in more frequent testing. E.g. repairs, modifications, or manufacturer recommendations.
- Tests for structural integrity or leaks using pressurized gas, including air, are generally prohibited.
- Hydrostatic testing shall be the preferred method unless manufacturer recommendations state otherwise.



LHE INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND RENTAL



- Approximately 130 Cranes in need of periodic inspection.
- Approximately 40 sites in need of periodic inspection of Below-the-Hook Rigging.
- Preventative Maintenance to be performed on LHE in accordance with manufacture recommendations.
- Repairs to be performed on LHE in accordance with manufacture recommendations.
- Rental of Cranes with and without Operators from 15 T Carry Decks to 165 T Mobile Cranes.
- Load Testing of LHE equipment as required.
- Other services sought through this contract are Inspections, Testing, Maintenance and Repairs of Forklift Lifts and Personnel Lifts.
- As indicated on the pervious map the Huntington District is large and encompasses 4 states; WV, KY, OH, VA, broken down into 5 Area Offices

Inspections and tests will be performed by personnel qualified in accordance with OSHA, ASME, and the EM 385-1-1.
