CONSTRUCTION QUALITY MANAGEMENT COURSE FOR CONTRACTORS

The Quality Management program that is used in Corps of Engineers contracts is examined in a course entitled **Construction Quality Management for Contractors**. In most new contracts, it is required that the **Construction Quality Control (CQC) System Manager** successfully completes the course (**UFGS 01 45 00.10 10**). The Huntington District offers this course **once a year** during the month of March.
