**SUBCROSSING REPAIRS**

**KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 40.2**

Reference Notice to Navigation Interests 18-32, dated 1 October 2018. The M/V TOM COOK will be replaced by the M/V COMPASS POINT.

All other pertinent information remains the same.

**For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 18-32:**

Notice is given that on or about 15 October 2018, Sunland

Construction, Inc. will begin repairs to a subcrossing for Kinder Morgan, Inc., along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 40.2.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V TOM COOK, two barge mounted cranes, and one twin outboard crew boat. The M/V TOM COOK and the crew boat will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. This work will be performed from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 7 days per week, with an anticipated completion date of 15 November 2018.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the worksite and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution,
