REVISION TO NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS 20-13

ENVIRONMENTAL CAPPING, STONE PLACEMENT

KANAWHA RIVER, MILES 33.8 - 42.4

Reference Notice to Navigation 20-13, dated 16 June, 2020. Effective immediately, the environmental capping work referenced below, will temporarily be performed 24 hrs per day, Monday through Saturday. On 23 August 2020, the work will return back to normal operating hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

All other pertinent information remains the same.

For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 20-13:

Notice is given that on or about 13 July 2020, JF Brennan will begin debris removal, environmental capping, and stone placement for Monsanto in close proximity to the channel of the Kanawha River at various locations between miles 33.8 - 42.4.

The contractors floating plant will consist of the M/V MASON TATE, the M/V MORGAN LIEGH, two crane flats, and two material barges. The vessels will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed Monday through Saturday, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., with an anticipated completion date of 18 November 2020.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the worksite and lighted according to regulations. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
