REVISION TO NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS 20-16

FRESHWATER MUSSEL SURVEY

KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 42.0

Reference Notice to Navigation 20-16, dated 13 August, 2020. The mussel survey work at Kanawha River, mile 42.0 has a revised start date of 25 August and a revised completion date of 1 September.

All other pertinent information remains the same.

For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 20-16:

Notice is given, that on or about 17 August 2020, TRC Environmental Corporation, will conduct freshwater mussel surveys for the WVDOH, on the Kanawha River, mile 42.0, along both banks and within the navigation channel.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of a 20 foot dive boat. Dive vessels will display the international alpha code and recreational dive flags while performing under and above water work. The contractor will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., seven days a week with an anticipated completion date of 25 August 2020.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be removed from the river. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
