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## **REVISION TO NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTEREST 13-16**

### **BANK STABILIZATION**

#### **KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 52.1**

Reference Notice to Navigation Interests 13-16, dated 7 May 2013. The revised completion date is on or about 25 May 2013. From there, the floating plant will move to Kanawha River Mile 62.5, along the left descending bank to conduct bank stabilization. This phase of the work will end on or about 27 June, 2013.

All other pertinent information remains unchanged.


#### **For your convenience, the following is from Notice to Navigation Interests 13-16:**

Notice is given that on or about 20 May, 2013, ABC Corp., will begin placing river bank slope protection along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 52.1.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V SAM S, one barge mounted crane, and one material barge. The M/V SAM S will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. This work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., 5 days per week, with an anticipated completion date of 3 June, 2013.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the worksite and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
