CORE BORING


KANAWHA RIVER 39.9

Notice is given that on or about 31 May 2013, Amherst Madison Inc. will commence core drilling operations on the Kanawha River, mile 39.9. Work will consist of drilling three core samples across the navigation channel. The navigation channel will not be closed during this operation.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of M/V ANDY MULLINS, one crane mounted barge, and one work flat barge. The tow boat will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and is expected to be completed on or about 07 June 2013.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the worksite, along the left descending bank, and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake, and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
