MOORING CELL CONSTRUCTION


KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 39.0

Notice is given that on or about 8 January 2014, Richard Goettle, Inc. will commence mooring cell construction for John Amos Plant, along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 39.0.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V ANDREW J, two barge mounted cranes, one deck barge, one hopper barge, and four flexi floats. The M/V ANDREW J will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and is anticipated to be completed on or about 17 April 2014.

The floating plant will be moored at the worksite during non-working hours and will be lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
