## DIVING OPERATIONS FOR MUSSEL SURVEYS

### OHIO AND KANAWHA RIVERS


#### HUNTINGTON DISTRICT

Notice is given that on or about 28 July 2014, Lewis Environmental Consulting, contractor for the Huntington District U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will conduct diving operations along various reaches on the Ohio and Kanawha Rivers as listed below. The work area description and tentative schedule is listed below. The International alpha code and recreational dive flags will be displayed.

The Dive Vessel Madison E. will be monitoring marine channel 13. Diving will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and it is anticipated that this work will be completed on or about 5 September 2014

28-31 July: Below Belleville Dam along the left descending bank	Ohio River mile 204.9
1-4 August: Below R.C. Byrd Dam along the right descending bank	Ohio River mile 280.0
5-10 August: Witchers Island across navigation channel	Kanawha River mile 70.9
11-19 August: Hurricane Creek Bar across navigation channel	Kanawha River miles 28-30
20-23 August: Below Winfield Dam along the left descending bank	Kanawha River mile 30.7
24-30 August: Old lock 31 along the left descending bank	Ohio River mile 358.5
31 Aug- 5 Sep: Bonanza Bar along the left descending bank	Ohio River mile 354.0

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
