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**TEMPORARY LOADING AND UNLOADING SITE**

**KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 88.4**

Notice is given that on or about 15 October 2016, Kanawha Crane & Construction, Inc. will begin loading and unloading equipment for the Cranberry Pipeline, along the left descending bank of the Kanawha River, mile 88.4.

The floating plant will consist of the M/V CAPTAIN EDWARD F. SMITH, one barge mounted crane, and one deck barge. The M/V CAPTAIN EDWARD F. SMITH will be monitoring marine channel 13 and 16. This work will be performed from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., seven days a week, with an anticipated completion date of 15 January 2017.

During non-working hours the floating plant will be moored at the work site and lighted according to regulations.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution.
