CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

HUNTINGTON DISTRICT

OHIO RIVER

Notice is given that Amherst Madison, contractor for the US Army Corp of Engineers, has commenced channel maintenance dredging on the Ohio River for the Huntington District, USACE. Disposal operations will take place at the permitted sites located at each project.

The contractor's floating plant will consist of the M/V FLORANCE T, M/V EARL FRANKLIN, one barge mounted crane, and two material barges. The vessels will be monitoring marine channel 13 and should be contacted for passing arrangements. Dredging will be performed from 6:00 AM through midnight, 7 days per week. A government dredge inspector will be in attendance at each site.

Navigators are requested to be alert to the location of the dredge and its disposal operations. It is essential that navigators await the passing signal from the dredge prior to proceeding with caution. During non-working hours, all equipment will be moored outside the navigation channel, marked and lighted according to regulations.
