DIVING OPERATIONS

MUSSEL SURVEY AND RELOCATION

KANAWHA RIVER, MILE 73.3 TO 73.5

Notice is given that on or about 18 September 2017, EnviroScience Inc. will conduct diving operations along left descending bank, extending out to mid-channel on the Kanawha River, mile 73.3 to 73.5, below the Chelyan Bridge.

The contractors floating plant will consist of two dive vessels, the DANNY DEE and the E.O. WILSON, along with a 18 ft johnboat. Dive vessels will display the International alpha code and recreational dive flags while performing under and above water work. The crew will be monitoring marine channels 13 and 16. The work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Sunday with an anticipated completion date of 30 September 2017.

During non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored downstream at the Chesapeake Boat and Marina.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
